**Watercolour Surface:** Watercolour Paper 140lb/300gsm approx. A4 size or slightly larger. Paper Suitable for whichever media being used.

**Brushes:** No. 2 Hog hair Fan brush, No. 8 Round nylon brush, a 1" Flat nylon brush, and a fine rigger/liner brush

**Sundries:** A board slightly larger than your paper, masking tape, kitchen roll, 2b sketching pencil
